Who We Are and What We Do!

The Macomb Charitable Foundation is a group of volunteers who seek out and assist homeless and poverty stricken children in our community.

We are all volunteer, no one gets paid. This means that 100% of the profit realized from any fundraising event will be used to make a difference in the life of a child.

We assist with things that other agencies cannot. We pay for tutoring, after-school activities, band instruments, field trips, athletic fees, etc. We believe that keeping a child active and involved in their school means less time they will be spending on the street. We are contacted by Social Service agencies, teachers, principals, and churches to assist children in need. We put in countless hours raising money, making home visits, mentoring, advising and returning calls.

Homeless children in Macomb County?

You bet. Lots of them. We believe that what we do makes a difference.





We have lived on the streets in motels and a DV shelter. We have been covered in bedbug bites so many times. It's been so hard on us all. My mom lost a job she loved back in June and because we move around so much and have no car she hasn't been able to find another job. My dad is on SSD so we depend on my mom working. She wants to go to school again to be a nurse and can't cause we are homeless. I wish we had a home again. We all are stuck in a small motel room when we have money and it's hard. It's been a horrible year for me

It's been a very tough year for me and my family because.....



