## How your gift is spent...

When asked to give to a charity, it's important that donors know how their donation is being used. At Macomb Charitable, we take great pride in being an all-volunteer group. This allows your entire gift to be used for a child in need. During the first part of 2016, we have assisted children in the following ways:

- © Provided emergency shelter assistance for 18 families consisting of 48 children.
- © Assisted 21 families (56 kids) with security deposits, getting them OFF the streets and into affordable housing.
- © Assisted the above families with gently-used furniture, bedding, towels, dishes, silverware, end tables, lamps etc.
- © Purchased 100 book bags for homeless children in Macomb County.
- © Provided 102 families (more than 250 children) with emergency food assistance via gift cards.

- © Provided 8 single, WORKING moms (21 children) who were previously homeless with utility assistance.
- © Helped 8 homeless high school seniors attend their Senior Prom.
- Assisted 29 homeless families (69 children) with laundry vouchers to wash their clothes.
- © Purchased 400 pairs of NEW SHOES for 200 homeless and poverty-level children in Macomb.
- © Purchased school clothing and supplies for 59 homeless children (this is in addition to the 100 kids we took school shopping in the fall).

As this newsletter goes to print, we are working on finding a home for two vehicles. One was donated by Gentile's Collision and the other by Brian and Kim Doyle. These vehicles will be life changing for two homeless families where the parents are working and need dependable transportation. The above list could go on and on... we provided beds, bedding, tutoring, eye glasses, dental assistance, diapers, formula, summer camps etc. All for children in our community who are living below poverty level and/or are homeless, sleeping in shelters, motels, family vehicles etc. We honor your donation by verifying each request, making sure the need is legitimate. We do our best to make sure your gift MAKES A DIFFERENCE.

# 400 NEW pairs of shoes! 200 children benefit from your generosity!



The Macomb Charitable Foundation is a group of volunteers who seek out and assist homeless and poverty stricken children in our community.

We pay for tutoring, after-school activities, band instruments, field trips, athletic fees, etc. We believe that keeping a child active and involved in their school means less time they will be spending on the street. We put in countless hours—raising money, making home visits, mentoring, advising and returning calls.

# Did you know...?

The average age of a homeless child in Michigan is 7.6 years old.

54% of the Michigan homeless population are children.

Nationally, 50% of all homeless women and children are on the street because of violence in their home.

Homeless families are likely to be headed by a single mother in her 20's.

1 out of every 10 Michigan children have a parent who is incarcerated.

For many Macomb County homeless children, their main meal of the day

is the Free or Reduced lunch they receive at school.

By age 12, 83% of homeless children will have experienced at least one violent act.
